Paper Submission and Review Process

Papers should describe original and unpublished work on the topics of the conference. Prospective authors should prepare a full paper, written in english, not exceeding 8 pages and must submit it electronically. All manuscripts will be blind-reviewed by at least two members of the program committee. All accepted papers will appear in the conference proceedings, to be published in Springer LNCS series. A copy of the proceedings will be distributed to all participants at the Conference.

Submission implies that at least one of the authors has to register and to present the communication at the conference if the paper is accepted.

IAPR Best Paper Prize at IbPRIA 2007

We are proud to announce that IAPR is sponsoring the Best Paper Prize at IbPRIA'2007 considering both outstanding contributions in the field of Pattern Recognition and Image Analysis as well as oral presentation aspects. The best paper will be selected out of a short list of 9 papers which received the highest scores during the review process, while the final decision will be taken by a Committee of 8 experts after attending their oral presentations during the two first days of IbPRIA'2007 Conference. The award carries a cash prize of 600 euros which will be given at the Gala Dinner of the Conference. A Diploma will be given to second and third best scored papers as an acknowledgement of their quality.
